DESCRIPTION

REAR SUBFRAME MOUNTING BUSHES

INSTALLATION GUIDE

Contents (parts per pack):

4 x PFR3-1120A Bushes 1 x PTFE/Silicone Grease

4 x PFR3-1120B Bushes 4 x Stainless Steel Sleeves

4 x Stainless Steel Washers

Please read the complete fitting instructions and check package components before fitment. These fitting instructions are to be used as a guide and in conjunction with workshop manual. It is recommended that:

- -all work to be carried out by a licensed technician;
- -all safety precautions adhered to;
- -wheel alignment to be checked and adjusted as required after any suspension work.
- -All fasteners must be tensioned to manufacturer's torque settings.

Fitting Instructions:

1. Remove the original Bush from the subframe, and remove any dirt and corrosion from the vacant hole.

Note: Keep the cast washer and the spring pins aside after removing the bush, as these will be needed once the new bush is fitted.

- 2. File away any sharp edges from the vacant hole.
- 3. Insert the bushes into the bore, with PFR3-1120A (smaller top hat) on the topside and PFR3-1120B (larger top hat) on the bottom.
- 4. Insert the Spring Pins into the smaller holes on each Stainless Steel Sleeve (2 per sleeve), until they sit flush.
- 5. Apply some of the supplied grease to the bores of the Bushes and insert the Stainless Steel Sleeves, until they sit flush.

Note: Ensure the orientation of each sleeve offset corresponds with Figure 2, which shows the correct position of each sleeve. The 2 front bushes' offset should be pointing towards the front of the car, and the 2 rear bushes should be facing the rear of the car.

6. Place the original caster washer on the top of PFR3-1120B Bush, and the provided Washer on the PFR3-1120A bush and refit the subframe. Remember to tension all hardware to manufacturers recommended torque settings.
